Graham Beck Brut NV

Beautiful harmony between lengthy Chardonnay and fragrant Pinot Noir. The result is a sparkling wine with a fine mousse giving freshness and finesse elegant ripe fruit and light yeast aromas and a rich creamy complexity on the palate.

Graham Beck Brut Rosé NV

Pale silver-pink aromas of raspberries, cherries and a few secondary whiffs of minerality. A lively mousse but fine in the mouth with subtle red berry flavours enlivened by bright acids. Brisk on the palate showing hints of oyster shell and fresh lavender.

Graham Beck Blanc de Blancs 2007

With its aromas and flavours of brioche, lees, honeyed oak and citrus and its creamy texture, the Graham Beck Blanc de Blancs is a ringer for a non-vintage Champagne. Made of 100 percent Chardonnay aged three years on the lees. About 50 percent of the base wine is barrel fermented, with 5 percent new oak. Done in quite a modern style with a more fresh than oxidized character.

Last year, Barack Obama celebrated the US presidential election victory with a glass of Graham Beck as it's his wife Michelle's, favourite bubbly – as did Nelson Mandela when he toasted his 1994 inauguration.

The Telegraph chose the Graham Beck Brut NV as one of the Ten best South African wines for 2010 and wine critic Matthew Jukes chose the 2005 Graham Beck Blanc de Blanc as his number one wine of the year. We visited both the estates in Robertson and Franschhoek and enjoyed the wines so much that we simply had to list them.

Acacia Tree Chenin Colombard 2011 *Western Cape*

Fresh citrus and peach flavours with zippy acidity and a refreshing finish.

Cederberg Five Generations Chenin Blanc 2008 *Cederberg*

Delicate aromas of honey and lime zest laced with sweet vanilla undertones. Well integrated wood and ageing on the lees developed a full, rich palate with a smooth, lingering finish.

The nose shows rich apricot and honey, subtle oak and a fine mineral character. The palate is rich and round with a long finish and with ripe fruit and vanilla oak in perfect harmony.

Honey, butterscotch and mineral notes, citrus and tropical fruit come through with a touch of herbal notes, feeling generous, but still closely wound.

Upfront tropical fruit, ripe pineapple, melon, peaches and honey flavours on the nose. Full and juicy palate with layers of ripe tropical fruit. Complemented by a long clean and crisp aftertaste.

Packed with up front tropical fruit, the nose charms with an abundance of guava and gooseberries.

Aged for 12 months in the same oak regime as the regular Chenin Blanc with the fruit picked a little riper, well-defined bouquet with very well integrated oak and hints of hazelnut and spice.

Chenin Blanc is perhaps the most adaptable wine grape variety of all. Taken from its home of the Loire Valley it is used differently around the world to make either Fortified white, Sparkling wine, Sweet wine, and Dry white wine. It is also the most popular dry white wine style from in South Africa where it is locally known as 'Steen'.

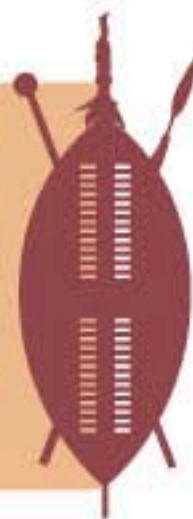

Alsace is a region in eastern France which borders Germany on the north and east and Switzerland on the south. Along with Austria and Germany, it produces some of the most sought after dry Rieslings in the world, but perhaps even more noted for highly aromatic Gewurztraminer wines. Pinot Grigio, which is best known as a light dry wine from Italy, is a clone of the Alsace grape Pinot Gris. These wines are all incredibly food friendly – the Delheim Gewurztraminer and the Thelema "Sutherland" Riesling are more aromatic in style and great with slightly spicier foods, whereas the Flat Roof Manor Pinot Grigio and the Jordan Riesling are both dry and perfect partners to any of our fish dishes.
