2012	DOM.CROIX BELLE - GRENACHE BLANC / VIOGNIER Languedoc, France	25.00	Delightful, modern Southern French white; rich peach and apricot fruit balanced by fine acidity and a touch of new oak.
2012	CAVE DE HUNAWIHR RIESLING RESERVE Alsace, France	32.00	With European wines Shooting up in price due to the Euro this is a bargain find. Top notch Alsace Riesling with a lovely ripeness.

2011	CORALILLO GEWURZTRAMINER San Antonio Chile	36.00	Beautifully fresh and restrained Gerwurtz from a cool climate vineyard. Intense fruit with hints of rose, lychee and grapefruit.

2012	BENITO SANTOS - ALBARINO Rias Baixas, Spain	36.00	Albarino is the grape du jour which inevitably means that it's hard to find a top-notch one at a fair price. However, this has it all, medium-bodied, slightly creamy green apple fruit and lovely structure and length. Spain's best white wine region and grape.
2011	ST MICHELLE RIESLING Washington State, USA	35.00	One of the West Coast's longest established wineries. The cool Washington climate gives a remarkably refined, crisp Riesling with just a touch of white peach fruit.
2010	ALMALARGA GODELLO Pena Las Donas Spain	38.00	This is quite frankly the best Spanish white we've ever tasted. Startling fresh, rich, mineral fruit from 80 to 100 year old wines from the indigenous Godello grape variety.
2011	MATAKANA PINOT GRIS Matakana New Zealand	37.00	New Zealand Pinot Gris just keeps on wowing us: Lush creamy peach, quince and cloves notes wrapped up in lovely balanced, fresh acidity

2009	SALICE SALENTINO, AGRICOLLE VALONNE Puglia Italy	29.00	This producer is consistently rated amongst the best in Puglia. This warm and generous southern Italian red made, from Negroamaro, provides a wonderful balance of sweet ripeness and bitterness typical of this grape.
2007	CALITERRA TRIBUTE - CABERNET SAUVIGNON Chile	31.00	An environmentally friendly wine made to an exeptional standard. Text book blackcurrant fruit with just the right amount of oak to overlay softness and complexity.
2006	SANTA MONICA MERLOT RESERVA Rapel Valley, Chile	31.00	Very characteristic Merlot fruit with a touch of oak.. Nice structure, elegant and refined. Quite old world in style.

2010	TRAPICHE CABERNET FRANC Mendoza, Argentina	33.00	The intensity of this dark, tannic, rich variety has been softened by 15 months aging in new French and American oak - a very interesting red
2011	CH LE PEY CRU BOURGEOIS Medoc, France	34.00	This is a lovely little Cru Bourgeois claret. 2009 wasn't a great year, but this is remarkably good - showing a decent weight of fruit and a classic Bordeaux stalky nose.
2011	CLOS DES FOUS CAUQUENINA Maule, Chile	36.00	Classic aromas of cherries and plums, with a hint of redcurrant. Attractive wet, earthy floral notes are also present, like a good compost heap, integrated with savoury mushroom and toasted oak
2011	TINPOT HUT PINOT NOIR Marlborough, New Zealand	40.00	Made from grapes sourced from vineyards located in extreme conditions,this blend of Malbec, Carmanere, Shiraz, Pais and Carignan produces a layers of different characters on the palate rounded by a fine tannins.
2010	BERRY BROS. EXTRA ORDINARY CLARET Bordeaux, France	43.00	Berrys have access to some of the best wines in Bordeaux. This privileged position really shows ion the consistently excoellent quality of their house claret.

2010	BODEGAS Y VIÑOS ARTADI VIÑAS DE GAIN Rioja, Spain	46.00	Possibly Spain's greatest Rioja - certainly so in the new wave style. Clean, silky, elegant and structured with a lovely refined smokiness from maturation in new French oak.
2010	EIKENDAL VINEYARDS - "CLASSIQUE BORDEAUX BLEND", Stellenbosch, S.A	46.00	This blend coats the classic cabernet sauvignon backbone with the velvet glove of merlot enhanced with the density and intensity of cabernet franc. As good as a top claret at half the price
2006	CH LAMOTHE CISSAC Bordeaux, France	55.00	A cracking little Claret: Lamothe Cissac is a consistently good Cru Bourgeois from a vintage that is just right for drinking now.
2009	SMITH & HOOK Central Coast, California	57.00	One of California's top reds. Huge extract and deep, rich red berry notes combined with a touch of earthy complexity. A real steak wine.
2008	VACQUERAS "LA PAVANE" PERRIN ET FILS Rhone, France	47.00	Gorgeous, classic Rhone, dark purpley red, rich spicy, bramble fruit and lovely structure.
