*We have combined Wray and Nephew rum with Licor 43, freshly squeezed lemon juice, passion fruit sugar syrup, apple juice and a pinch of cinnamon to make this tropical drink.*

### **Cucumber Cooler**

*A light, sweet and refreshing drink made from Hendricks gin, Licor 43 and cool crushed cucumber with lemon juice and sugar.*

### **The Singer's Delight**

*If ever an excuse for a cocktail was needed, here it is. With "medicinal" qualities, this combination of Krupnik, ginger syrup, honey and lemon is sure to sooth a sore throat with every delectable sip.*

### **Wild Martini**

*Take a walk on the wild side with this mouth-watering combination of Wild Turkey bourbon, Hennessy Fine de Cognac and Martini Rosso, delightfully sweetened with a dash of sugar and a swirl of apple juice.*

### **Dizzy Spells**

*This drink is made with Hoxton gin which is infused with coconut and grapefruit. Add crushed watermelon and fresh mint to make this delicious cocktail.*

### **Porthito**

*A twist on the classic mojito which brings a storm of a cocktail in the form of muddled blackberries and port.*

### **The Hummingbird**

*The hummingbird loves the hibiscus flower. It feeds upon it for its luscious, refreshing flavour and aroma. This cocktail combines hibiscus, lime, mint and manzana verde with Appleton 12 yr. old rum for the perfect amount of ease and kick.*

## CLASSICS

**Classics are drinks that have stood the test of time, and at Ronnie's we have put together some examples of classic drinks that, whilst perhaps sounding familiar, we feel are often overlooked or poorly made. The following are our versions; they are as tasty as they are simple.**

### **Treacle**

*A creation brought to us by the renowned cocktail Guru, Dick Bradsell. Well known for his playful side, (he invented bar cricket!) using Appleton Estate 12, the Treacle is a creative twist on the original Old Fashioned.*

### **Cosmopolitan**

*Since the birth of the Cosmopolitan in the 1970's, it holds its own amongst more contemporary cocktails to remain a siren of sophistication. Our version is made with Ketel One Citron and Cointreau, cranberry juice and freshly squeezed lime.*

### French Martini

*In true Martini style, the perfect partnership of such simple ingredients makes the French Martini highly popular. We combine Ketel One, Pineapple juice and the versatile French liqueur Chambord to make a rich, sweet favourite.*

### Martini

*Originally made with gin but also popular with vodka. We recommend Tanqueray gin and Belvedere vodka but you can choose any from our extensive list. Served with olives or a lemon twist.*

### Whisky Sour

*Made with Chivas Regal 12 year old Whisky.*

### Tom Collins

*"Have you seen Tom Collins?" This question was most often followed by an elaborately constructed story about a nonexistent person, in the hope the recipient would rush off to find the phantom nearby 'Tom Collins'. Our Tom Collins however will be sure to provide a more satisfying end to a search with its refreshing blend of Tanqueray, freshly squeezed lemon juice and sugar syrup, topped with soda.*

### Bramble

*Another creation of the great Dick Bradsell, the Bramble is an admirable cocktail, with its smooth taste and its bright, refreshing palate, consisting of berries and herbs. Born in the mid 1980's it remains a popular English cocktail using Tanqueray, Chambord, sugar syrup, fresh lemon juice with a float of crème de mure and a blackberry garnish.*

### Daiquiri

*The Daiquiri is one for a true rum aficionado, the simplicity of the ingredients lets the true taste of the rum shine. Our Daiquiris are made using Appleton Estate VX, produced in the vast Nassau valleys and left to age in small oak barrels, combined with fresh lime juice and sugar to create a rich, refreshing flavour.*

### The Old Fashioned

*Possibly the first drink in history to be referred to as a cocktail. This drink's age as indicated in its name is evident in the maturity of its ingredients: a blend of bitters and brown sugar which fully compliments the caramel, syrupy smooth tones of Auchentoshen Three Wood.*

### Mojito

*Everybody knows it; everybody loves it. A real Cuban classic.*

### Caipirinha

*Think of the beautiful, vibrant, sun-soaked, pulsating Brazil, then taste their best kept ex-secret, the Caipirinha. A common carnival cocktail which we make using Sagatiba Pura, a true Brazilian spirit.*

### Mai Tai

*You can't go far wrong with this Trader Vic invention when the name itself means 'Out of this world!' A delicious mix of rum, pineapple and lime with apricot brandy.*
