## Whisky

<p><b>Ardbeg 10 Year Old</b>  Ardbeg Ten Years Old is revered around the world as the peatiest, smokiest, most complex single malt of them all. Yet it does not flaunt the peat; rather it gives way to the natural sweetness of the malt to produce a whisky of perfect balance.</p>	46%
<p><b>Auchentoshan Classic Malt</b>  A Lowland single malt whisky from the Auchentoshan distillery, no age statement is given and one assumes it is a younger malt though certainly an enjoyable one. 'Classic'</p>	40%

was launched in 2008 to replace the old staple 'Select'.

**Bunnahabhain 12 Year Old** 46.3%

A giant leap forward for Bunnahabhain 12yo, this edition was launched in summer 2010 with a jump in strength to 46.3% and a declaration of no chill-filtration and no added colouring. Enormous credit goes to Burn Stewart for giving punters what they want without jacking up the price too much and we earnestly hope that this will be a massive success. Bravo!

**Dalwhinnie 15 Year Old** 43%

A great malt which Jim Murray awarded 95 points in his Whisky Bible, this is excellent value for money. The flavours are simple, but flawless, a clean, crisp 15 year old from the Dalwhinnie distillery, also part of Diageo's Classic Malts range.

**Glenkinche 12 Year Old** 43%

One of the few remaining Lowland distilleries, Glenkinchie's rural location amid fields of barley, just twenty miles from the hustle and bustle of the capital, makes this "The Edinburgh Malt".

**Glenlivet 12 Year Old** 40%

The entry level bottling from the illustrious Glenlivet distillery at Speyside's heart, aged for 12 years. The archetypal Speyside dram, honey and orchard fruit driven.

**Highland Park 12 Year Old** 40%

The entry level bottling from Scotland's most northerly distillery, Highland Park, aged for 12 years with plenty of citrus and green notes.

**Isle Of Jura Origin 10 Year Old** 40%

A core bottling from the Isle of Jura's only distillery. This 10 year old has exhibits the distillery's classic oily, briny characteristics.

**Lagavulin 16 Year Old** 43%

A much sought-after single malt with the massive peat-smoke that's typical of southern Islay - but also offering richness and a dryness that turns it into a truly interesting dram. The 16 year old has become a benchmark Islay dram from the Lagavulin distillery.

<b>Laphroaig 10 Year Old</b>	40%
Really smoky and iodine rich. This has to be one of Scotland's most characterful drams. Laphroaig are known for their medicinal malts, and the classic 10 year old is no exception.	
<b>Talisker 10 Year Old</b>	45.80%
A classic Island dram from the Isle of Skye. Always highly rated, this was an Editor's Choice at Whisky Magazine. Lots of spice and fresh, tangy peat.	
<b>Macallan Gold</b>	40%
This is the new no-age-statement Single Malt Scotch Whisky from the famous Speyside distillery of Macallan. Macallan's new range has done away with age-statements and instead focuses on the colour of the whisky. The concept being that the older the whisky is the darker it will be... Regardless of how true this really is, it's certainly a great whisky packed with assertive vanilla and citrus flavours.	
<b>Jamesons Irish Whiskey</b>	40%
Produced at the Midleton Distillery, Jameson is Ireland's quintessential Irish blend, a classic. Jim Murray even awarded it an incredible 95 points!	

## **Rum** **ABV(%)**

<b>Goslings Black Seal Rum</b>	40%
A brilliant dark rum for sipping or mixing, produced in Bermuda since 1806. The name comes from the black wax originally used to seal the bottles.	
<b>Pussers Rum</b>	40%
<b>Skipper Rum</b>	40%
A traditional Guyanese dark rum with the unique stamp of quality Demerara Distilled from sugar-cane and molasses, aged in oak casks before blending.	

**Old J Spiced Rum** 35%

One of the many bottlings chasing after the flavour of the last generation of spiced rum, and one that comes pretty close. Rich and sweet with a fair whack of vanilla in the mix.

**Red Leg** 37.5%

RedLeg is a superb spiced rum made with Caribbean spirit which was aged in old oak whilst being infused with Jamaican vanilla and ginger. Just superb and very good on a crisp Winter's evening!

**The Kraken Spiced Rum** 40%

An excellent spiced rum, with utterly brilliant packaging! This was launched in the UK in early 2010, and it has an extraordinarily rich, spicy flavour. Named for the legendary sea monster, Kraken is a blend of Caribbean rums that should certainly suit any fans of rich, navy-style rum.

**Vodka** ABV(%)

**Luksusowa Vodka** 40%

A fantastically creamy triple-distilled potato vodka with a lightly sweet finish, 'Luksosowa' is the Polish term for 'luxury vodka' and it's not difficult to see why.

**Gin** ABV(%)

**Haymans London Dry Gin** 40%

An excellent london dry gin, this was created by Christopher Hayman, a man with over 40 years experience in the gin world. He uses juniper, coriander, orange and lemon peel to craft his distinctive gin, loads of flavour, loads of body - makes for a great Martini!

**Brandy** ABV(%)

**Courvoisier XXX Brandy**

Courvoisier VS is a rich and smooth cognac with fine depth of flavour, with hints of oak and subtle fruit tones, made mainly from Fins Bois cognacs. Legend has it that Napoleon took many cases of Courvoisier with him on exile, hence the sobriquet 'Le Cognac de Napoleon'.

**Bourbon****ABV(%)****Buffalo Trace**

The new edition of the classic Kentucky straight bourbon, Buffalo Trace. A great whiskey, with oodles of vanilla, barrel char and spicy complexity.

**Jim Beam**

Made to the same formula since 1795, this giant of the category is aged for four years in oak barrels to create a smooth, mellow taste with hints of spice.
