The very essence of its environment, malt whisky is like the Scots tongue, broadly one language, yet within that, so many different dialects, each one unique to its distillery. It is this subtle distinction which gives every malt its unmistakable identity.

Whisky or Whiskey is a type of distilled alcoholic beverage made from fermented grain mash. Different grains are used for different varieties, including barley, malted barley, rye, malted rye, wheat and corn. Whisky is typically aged in wooden oak casks, made generally of charred white oak.

ISLAY

Islay whiskies are among Scotland's most powerful, thunderous drams. Often with plenty of peat and smoke, brine and medicinal flavours, such examples are Ardbeg, Laphroaig or Lagavulin. However not all Islay malts are heavily peated. Of all the whisky regions of Scotland Islay has attained a truly iconic status.

ARBEG - ISLE OF ISLAY, PORT ELEN

The Ardbeg distillery lies in a small cove off the south coast of Islay. Due to its remote location, it was once a stage for illegal distillation and smuggling. In 1815, the distillery owner John McDougall established the distillery as a legitimate enterprise. The distillery then ran into financial difficulty and eventually closed in 1981. It was not until Glenmorangie acquired it in 1997 that the distillery got a new lease of life and started producing whisky once more.

10 YEAR OLD 46% 4.1

For peat-lovers, Ardbeg 10 year old is probably the highest quality 'entry-level' single malt on the market, and the distillery many Islay connoisseurs would choose as their favourite. A whirlwind of peat and complex malty flavours, this is an exuberant, in-your-face whisky to be cherished

CORRYVRECKAN 57.1% 6.2

Corryvreckan takes its name from the famous whirlpool that lies to the north of Islay, where only the bravest souls dare to venture. Swirling aromas and torrents of deep, peaty and peppery taste lurk beneath the surface of this beautifully balanced dram. With notes of smoke, citrus fruit and spices

PERPETUUM 47.4% 12.9

Released during Feis Ile 2015 to celebrate Ardbeg's 200th anniversary, this is a blend of old and young whisky, matured in both bourbon and sherry casks, delivering the classic Ardbeg note of cured meats, smoke and sea spray.

ISLAY

UIGEADAIL 54.2 % 5.5

A fine drop of Ardbeg bottled at cask strength. A marriage of Ardbeg from bourbon barrels and sherry butts which gives a sweet and smoky finish to this malt. Uigeadail is the loch from which all Ardbeg water flows. An absolutely stunning whisky, that some believe to be the core of the range.

LAGAVULIN - ISLE OF ISLAY

Referred to as the "Prince of Islay", Lagavulin has been around since 1816. Despite the pungency of the single malt, there is a certain smoothness to the palate which many attribute to the leisurely rate of distillation. 98% for this spirit is used for the single malt market.

LAGAVULIN 8 "LIMITED EDITION" 48% 7.95

Released to commemorate the 200th anniversary of the founding of Lagavulin distillery by John Johnston in 1816, this eight-year-old is big and smoky, with sweet spice that becomes apparent with a drop of water. A fitting tribute for the milestone.

12 YEAR OLD CASK STRENGTH 55.1% 8.9

Lagavulin 12 Year Old is an amazing whisky from this awarded distillery. Bottled at natural strength this single malt is fabulously appetising. A Kildalton coast classic it is simply excellent. Big flavours, but well balanced. cocoa, seaweed and sweet well-barbecued vegetable kebabs.

16 YEAR OLD 43% 5.3

This multi-award winning dram hardly needs any introduction. Thick & rich, with flavours of Lapsang Souchong. Sweet spices with thick peat smoke. An absolute classic. Try it with blue cheese, you'll be blown away.

DISTILLERS EDITION, 1997 43% 9

Distilled in 1997 & then bottled in 2014 following a finishing period in Pedro Ximenez casks. So much flavours right through this whisky. This is big & bold malt.

ISLAY

LAPHROAIG - ISLE OF ISLAY

No one knows the full history of Laphroaig as much of it has been lost in the midst of time unfortunately. It is clear the Irish had been distilling here for many years & that the locals picked up the skills when they left. Founded in 1815, it is named for the area of land at the head of Loch Laphroaig on the south coast on the Isle.

10 YEAR OLD 40% 3.9

Laphroaig 10 is really smoky & iodine rich. This has to be one of Scotland's most characterful drams. Laphroaig's are known for their medicinal malts & the 10 year old delivers that in abundance.

SELECT 40% 4.5

A combination of Oloroso sherry butts, American white oak, and a hogshead flavoured with Pedro Ximenez quarter casks & first fill bourbon casks. A restrained & toned down version of Laphroaig.

25 YEAR OLD 45.1% 21.5

An exceptional release from Laphroaig, this superb Islay single malt has been matured for 25 years in a combination of first-fill Oloroso Sherry casks and ex-American bourbon barrels, then bottled at cask strength.

BOWMORE 12 YEAR OLD 40% 3.8

The heart of the Bowmore range, the 12 year old exhibits some beautiful coastal notes with a gentle peat, it is this balance that the floral element present that makes this a great entry bottling for Bowmore. Remarkably long & complex, vanilla ice cream at a beach bonfire.

BOWMORE DARKEST 15 YEAR OLD 43% 6

Matured in a combination of ex American bourbon & European sherry casks, this dram spends its final three years in Oloroso casks. Dark ripe fruits, rich treacle toffee & caramel, robust & complex. The sweet sherry tames the peat.

ISLAY

BOWMORE 18 YEAR OLD 43% 9.5

Nurtured in oak casks for 18 years, this is one of the finest malts of its kind. A truly long, well balanced and wonderful dram. A perfumed fruity dram, with hints of dark fruit and salted kippers.

BOWMORE 25 YEAR OLD 43% 17

A multi-international award winner, this exceptional whisky has matured for a quarter of a century in American Bourbon and Spanish sherry casks. The sherry influence combines wonderfully with the coastal smokey distillery style to create a sublime aged single malt.

BRUICHLADDICH

THE CLASSIC LADDIE UNPEATED 50% 5.3

This classic laddie is a non-age statement. Aroma's of pear, melon & a finish of vanilla & tropical fruits. A whisky as the name suggests a whisky to showcase the "Classic" Laddie Style.

BRUICHLADDICH

ISLAY. ROCKSIDE FARM 2007 50% 5.4

Made from barley that was harvested at Rockside Farm Islay. Distilled in 2007. The specially selected grain, the slow distillation and carefully considered casks were vital in creating this iconic unpeated single malt.

BRUICHLADDICH BLACK ART 49.2% 17

Bruichladdich Black Art is craftsmanship at its finest. With the recipe a mystery to everyone apart from the creator, it's still a cryptic enigma. Awesome whisky though!

ISLAY

BRUICHLADDICH OCTOMORE 6.1 57% 9.9

Distilled from 100% Islay barley. The sixth edition of the experimental Octomore. Whisky that is famous for being made with the most heavily peated barley on the planet currently sitting at 258PPM. Bruichladdich are still able to impart a delicate, graceful emphasis within this intense whisky.

BUNNAHABHAIN 12 YEAR OLD 46.3% 4.9

This 12 year old is lightly peated for an Islay single Malt and consequently is a light, fresh dram.

BUNNAHABHAIN 18 YEAR OLD 46.3% 9

This non-chill filtered, sherry matured whisky has dense, rich sherry notes, salted caramel & sticky toffee pudding. A whisky bottled the natural way a real triumph by Burn Stewart.

CAOL ILA 12 YEAR OLD 43% 4

Caol ila 12 is the entry level bottling from the Caol ila distillery. Launched in June 2002 this expression is light and fresh with that distinctive Caol ila smoke.

CAOL ILA DISTILLERS EDITION 2001 43% 8

A Distillers edition bottle of Caol ila single malt. Prior to bottling this whisky is matured in American oak before finishing in Moscatel wine casks, this imparts a more rich sweetness to this traditional smokey single malt. Sweet malty notes, warm peat and cinnamon spices.

ISLAY

CAOL ILA UNPEATED STITCHELL RESERVE 59.6% 9.5

Named after retired master distiller Billy Stitchell, this unpeated, limited edition whisky is natural cask strength, has been aged in a mix of refill American oak, ex-bodega European oak and rejuvenated American oak casks. Smooth and sweet, hints of baked green apples, a whiff of seaweed and despite being unpeated there is a smoky tang to this fine dram.

KILCHOMAN MACHIR BAY 46% 3.9

A vatting of 5 & 6 year old whisky matured in ex-bourbon barrels from Buffalo Trace married then finished in Oloroso Sherry butts for four weeks before bottling. Rich & creamy, sweet vanilla and dark chocolate, spicy clove & subtle smoke.

KILCHOMAN LOCH GORM 2015 46% 9.5

Loch Gorm, a well-sherried single malt Scotch whisky. A fine balance of whisky that has been matured in Oloroso Sherry butts and whisky matured in Sherry hogsheads. Glorious stuff! Bottled at around five years of age, it's an intensely smoky and sherried whisky, but carefully balances the peat and fruit.

KILCHOMAN 2009 PX CASK FINISHED, ABBAY WHISKY EXCLUSIVE 58.3% 12.5

Matured for over four and a half years in fresh bourbon barrels. The spirit is then transferred to a Pedro Ximénez cask for a further four months maturation. The PX softens things down a little but still allowing the dram to hold the traditional Kilchoman whisky character, a perfect combination.

SPEYSIDE

Though a comparatively small appellation, Speyside has, by some distance, the vast majority of Scotch whisky distilleries. Indeed there are currently some forty six working distilleries, although this number is viable for change.

The region can generally be classified into two styles of whisky, Light and grassy typified by Glenlivet, Glenfiddich or rich and sweet style exemplified by The Macallan & The Balvenie.

GLENFARCLAS - SPEYSIDE, BALLINDALLOCH

Multi-award winning Glenfarclas Single Highland Malt Scotch Whisky has been distilled on Speyside for six generations by one family – the Grants. Glenfarclas translates as meaning “Valley of the green grass”. Prized by connoisseurs, the single malt whiskies of Glenfarclas are matured almost solely in sherry butts & aged on site.

15 YEAR OLD 46% 5.7

An incredible dram from Glenfarclas. Dark and sherried, A great whisky from one of the best distilleries in Speyside. A sweet & malty dram that has a lovely long and spicy finish. It's a juicy Christmas cake of a whisky, absolutely huge! This 15 year old matured in sherry wood, a quite simply excellent dram

31 YEAR OLD PORT FINISH 42.8% 24.9

This is a well aged 31 year old whisky from Glenfarclas that has spent its entire life in a single Portuguese port cask. Expect seriously rich flavour here, sweet raisin, toffee nutmeg a delightfully spicy whisky.

SPEYSIDE

THE BALVENIE - SPEYSIDE, DUFFTOWN

In early 1892 work began to convert an 18th-century mansion (Balvenie New House) into a distillery. The building took fifteen months to complete and on 1 May 1893, the first distillation took place at the Balvenie Distillery. Balvenie produces whisky in a traditional style. The use of locally grown barley is preferred, and is floor malted

DOUBLEWOOD 12 YEARS 40% 4.8

This is a classic after dinner malts. Balvenie Doublewood's extra complexity and richness is a result of a second maturation in fresh sherry casks.

CARIBBEAN CASK 14 YEARS 43% 5.4

Aged in traditional oak cask for a 14 year period, then “finished” casks that previously held Caribbean rum. A fantastic well rounded whisky, with tropical fruit, toffee and vanilla.

DOUBLEWOOD 17 YEARS 43% 10.9

Matured in American oak casks before being transferred and finished in European oak sherry casks. Big notes of honey, green apple and vanilla. A very rich and complex whisky.

PORTWOOD 21 YEARS 40% 14.5

An additional period of maturation in 30 year-old port pipes has given this aged Balvenie an extra level of depth and concentration of flavour, adding potent fruit and smoke notes to the silky-smooth full-bodied palate. Rich, indulgent, after-dinner Speyside at its absolute finest.

SPEYSIDE

ABERLOUR A'BUNADH, BATCH 50 59.6% 5.7

Aberlour A'bunadh has reached its half century. Batch 50 is, as always, matured in Oloroso sherry butts – big, rich and full of fruit and nut flavours.

AUCHROISK 20 YEAR OLD 58.1% 14.9

Matured in part ex-Bourbon and part ex-Sherry casks, this is a superb 20 year old from Auchroisk. A poised, sweet and astonishingly sophisticated whisky. Ripe oranges, peaches and fig, with hints of fresh ginger.

AULTMORE 12 YEAR OLD 46% 4.8

Part of Dewar's The Last Great Malts range launched in 2014, this 12 year old Aultmore is the first release from the distillery for a few years, a refreshing dram that is elegant, light and fruity with lots of vanilla, honey & citrus.

BENROMACH 10 YEAR OLD 100 PROOF 57% 5.3

Benromach 10 year old bottled at a significantly higher strength 100° Proof intense and flavourful, notes of cracked black pepper with juicy fresh strawberry and raspberry... hints of orange peel and milk chocolate combine with a delicate smoky edge

BENROMACH 15 YEAR OLD 43% 4.65

A 2015 release. The Benromach 15 Year old is matured in a selection of Bourbon and Sherry casks, this results in a quite intense but wonderfully balanced dram

BENROMACH 30 YEAR OLD 43% 19.9

This fantastic thirty year old whisky from Speyside's smallest distillery is matured in first and refill casks to create this rich dram. Notes of rum soaked raisins, dark fruits and winter spice a fantastic rich dram.

BENROMACH ORGANIC 43% 4.25

The first Soil Association certified Organic single malt whisky, has enjoyed maturation in new oak, a well oaked dram, with lots of Caramel, Toffee and Spice.

SPEYSIDE

CARDHU 15 YEAR OLD 40% 4.9

Much-loved single malt, Cardhu is an easy-going, charming Speysider, characteristic orchard fruit, barley sugar malt and cake spices with richer tropical fruit and vanilla notes.

CRAGGANMORE 12 YEAR OLD 40% 4.1

A sherried 12 year old single malt from Diageo's Classic Malt range. This bottling from the Cragganmore distillery represents Speyside and offers a rich, slightly floral whisky with barley notes.

CRAIGELLACHIE 13 YEAR OLD 46% 5.3

One of the three official Craigellachie bottling's released in 2014, their 13 year old malt handsomely shows off the bold, robust character of the distillery's output. Oodles of dynamic fruit notes with a distinctive current of smoke running through it.

DAILUAINE MANAGERS CHOICE

1997 SINGLE CASK 58.6% 16.5

A single sherry cask of Dailuaine 1997, bottled at full strength by owners Diageo in 2009 as part of the Managers' Choice range.

SINGLETON OF DUFFTOWN 12 YEAR OLD 40% 3.6

A straight forward, biscuit, nutty and malty whisky from Speyside, the Singleton of Dufftown is aged in a high proportion of European oak casks. Smooth and elegant, this malt is designed to attract new drinkers to the whisky category.

GLEN ELGIN 12 YEAR OLD 43% 5.7

Glen Elgin 12 yrs is a single malt of breathtaking intensity, Stunningly fresh, mouth wateringly crisp and lush in barley, spice and ripe plum flavours, finishing with a dryish, slightly caramel-like note.

SPEYSIDE

GLENFIDDICH 12 YEAR OLD 40% 4.1

The classic Speyside is one of the biggest selling single malts in the world, aged in American & European oak casks, this award winning malt has flavours of honey, apple & pear. Very light and elegant single malt loved the world over.

GLENFIDDICH RICH OAK 40% 6

Rich Oak has spent 14 years in ex-bourbon casks in the traditional way, before two separate finishes of 12 weeks in new European oak and six weeks in new American oak before bottling. The American oak adds spice, vanilla and fruit, and the Spanish oak brings elegant fruit, spice and complexity.

GLENFIDDICH 15 YEAR OLD SOLERA 40% 4.8

Using a Solera system common used in the maturation of quality sherry, 15yo malt from their three casks of flavour, American Oak, European Oak and virgin American oak are then married together in a wooden vat, which is constantly topped up to ensure the quality is maintained. Flavours of rich dark fruit, sherry oak & marzipan.

GLENFIDDICH 18 YEAR OLD 40% 7.5

An elegant nose, faintly sweet, scented with apple and wood. Glenfiddich 18 year old is a robust and full-bodied single malt whisky, yet remains remarkably soft, rounded and long lasting.

GLENFIDDICH 21 YEAR OLD GRAN RESERVA 40% 11.2

After the whisky is matured for 21 years, the Malt Master adds even warmer and richer flavours by uniquely finishing this single malt in oak barrels that once contained rum from the Caribbean. The rum-soaked cask infuses the aged whisky with a spicy warmth and indulgent vanilla and toffee.

SPEYSIDE

GLENFIDDICH EXCELLENCE 26 YEAR OLD 43% 39.95

Excellence is a 26 year old expression from Glendiddich, aged exclusively in ex-bourbon casks sourced from Kelvin Cooperage in Kentucky, which just like Glenfiddich independently owned by a Scottish family.

THE GLENLIVET FOUNDERS RESERVE 40% 4.5

The opening from the Glenlivet range. Named in honour of the distillery's founder, George Smith. It's classic Glenlivet, with a creamy and fruity character bolstered by the use of first-fill American oak to mature some of the whisky.

THE GLENLIVET 18 YEAR OLD 43% 8.9

This excellent 18 year old single malt from Glenlivet is a classic Speyside dram. Big and well-rounded. Notes of chewy sultanas, sherried peels and barley sugars, toasty cereals with petals, green apples and orange peels.

THE GLENROTHES SELECT RESERVE 43% 5.9

A non vintage from The Glenrothes distillery. Whisky selected by The Glenrothes Malt Master, John Ramsay. Select Reserve is a fantastic example of a great Speyside dram. Bursting with flavour, lots of zesty fresh fruit with vanilla and that spicy house style.

SPEYSIDE

THE MACALLAN GOLD 40% 4.3

The Macallan Gold was released in late 2012 as part of a series of colour-themed bottlings introduced to replace the distillery's age-statement expressions. Gold has been produced from 9-15yo first fill and refill sherry casks and is designed to sit between the now-defunct 10yo Sherry Oak and 10yo Fine Oak bottlings.

THE MACALLAN AMBER 40% 5.3

An unsurprisingly, amber-coloured dram from Macallan. Part of the colour-named 1824 Series. It's matured in sherry casks and chosen to be more fully flavoured than the Gold but more restrained than the Sienna. A great example of what can be done with good-quality oak.

THE MACALLAN SIENNA 43% 8.3

The second darkest whisky in Macallan's 1824 Series, comprising of naturally coloured whiskies selected by hue and flavour. This has been matured in sherry casks and balances rich dried fruit sweetness with some lighter spicier notes.

THE MACALLAN RUBY 43% 15

The jewel in the crown of The Macallan's 1824 Series is erm, a Ruby! With the darkest hue in a no age statement range where colour is king, Ruby has spent the longest time in only the very finest sherry casks. The colour has been taken on naturally with no artificial colouring.

SPEYSIDE

THE MACALLAN RARE CASKS 43% 17.5

The Macallan Rare Cask single malt Scotch Whisky comprises of whiskies drawn from 16 different Sherry cask style, chosen by Macallan's Master Whisky Maker Bob Dalgarno. A high proportion of these casks are first fill, and has resulted in a rich, spicy Speyside single malt, bursting with honey'd raisin, root ginger and decadent chocolate notes, another fantastic release from The Macallan.

THE MACALLAN 25 YEAR OLD 43% 52.5

Superlative Speysider from Macallan, this astonishing 25 year old is one of the most revered whiskies in the world. It received a perfect 100 out of 100 score from the Beverage Testing Institute in Chicago, 1999. An absolute beast of a whisky. Very rich and complex. The Macallan at their finest

MORTLACH 16 YEAR OLD FLORA & FAUNA 43% 14

A cracking malt from a great, but criminally underexposed distillery. Rich, complex, spicy sherried character, a whisky lover favourite.

MORTLACH RARE OLD 43.4% 9.8

The first release from the new range of Mortlach single malts. This malt has come from a mixture of sherry & bourbon casks. Rich, with lots and lots of flavour, cinnamon stick, oak, vanilla and raisins with fruity jam biscuits.

TAMDHU 10 YEAR OLD 40% 4.2

A revitalised Tamdhu launched at the Spirit of Speyside festival in 2013. Sherry cask matured and full of all the sweet, rich and creamy flavours you'd expect.



HIGHLANDS

Scotland's largest whisky region boasts a dizzying array of styles. From rich and fruity to fragrantly floral. No style predominates here & a very diverse range of whiskies are produced which befits an ever changing landscape of coastline, moor and mountain

Technically speaking, the Islands have not been officially recognised as a region of its own and, as such, are included in the Highlands appellation. For the sake of precise classification, we shall choose to note the separation.

24 YEAR OLD GRANDEUR BATCH 006 48.9% 26.5

Glendronach's Grandeur is a 24 year old aged exclusively in the finest Oloroso sherry casks. Full bodied with a delicate sweetness, this is another excellent example of fine sherried Glendronach. This sherried single malt is right down your street if you enjoy the finer things in life. Orange blossom, Christmas spices and Golden Syrup.



HIGHLANDS

HIGHLAND PARK - HIGHLANDS, ISLANDS - ORKNEY, KIRKWALL

Highland Park is Scotland's northernmost whisky distillery. Lying just north of fellow Oracidian, Scapa. Founded in 1798 by a notorious smuggler. Officially licensed in 1826, the name of the whisky does not refer to the area of Scotland known as The Highlands, but rather to the fact that the distillery was founded on an area called 'High Park' distinguished from a lower area nearby.

12 YEAR OLD 40% 3.9

Highland Park 12 year old remains one of the golden standard malts for other distilleries to aspire to. With a delicious sweetness (heather honey is their preferred description) and a warming, silky mouth feel, this is a whisky that never lets you down.

18 YEAR OLD 43% 7.6

One of our all time favourites, this has to be one of the most consistently excellent malt whiskies of the last ten years. Showered with awards and praised from all quarters. Creamy and full of exotic fruit jam, espresso, toffee and honey. Unfailingly excellent, especially after a meal.

ODIN, 16 YEAR OLD 55.8% 19

The fourth and final entry in Highland Park's The Valhalla Collection. Odin (aka 'The Furious One'), is a rich, dark and mysterious whisky with the distillery's trademark sweet and gently peaty character. Aged for 16 years in a combination of first-fill sherry casks and refill hogsheads, this is a must for your bucket list.

FIRE EDITION, 15 YEAR OLD 45.2% 17.5

Fire Edition is a special release of just 28,000 bottles. Matured in 100% refill port wine casks giving the whisky a slight red hue which is natural colour. Intense aromas of ruby red fruits, light smoke and a beautiful long lingering finish.

HIGHLANDS

ABERFELDY 12 YEAR OLD 40% 3.9

A Fruity clean and polished malt. With a touch of honey, spice and fresh green apples. Aberfeldy 12 Year Old is an excellent introduction to this Highland distiller.

ARDMORE LEGACY 40% 3.9

Released in 2014, replaces the Ardmore Traditional, Legacy brings a lightly peated whisky with wood spice led flavour profile from the excellent Ardmore distillery.

BALBLAIR 1983 VINTAGE 46% 19.95

Matured in American oak ex-bourbon barrels, Balblair Vintage 1983 is a rich, warm dram, combining all core Balblair characteristics. A sweet & spicy dram that's sure not to disappoint.

CLYNELISH 14 YEAR OLD 46% 4.6

This is a superb example of what Clynelish can produce even at younger age. The balance is sublime and the mouth feel is perfectly rounded. Zesty orange, sweet floral and maritime flavours. A great 14 year old Highland malt.

THE DALMORE 12 YEAR OLD 40% 4.3

Launched in late 2008 to replace the previous 12 year old, this single malt from The Dalmore distillery is a toasty, coffee-rich dram with beautifully spiced notes and a thick mouth feel. Extremely rich for a 12 year old whisky.

HIGHLANDS

THE DALMORE 15 YEAR OLD 40% 6

The Dalmore 15 year old was first launched in 2007. Matured in amoroso matusalim apostoles sherry casks. It offers all those winter spices, orange zest and chocolate notes characteristic of The Dalmore

THE DALMORE CIGAR MALT RESERVE 44% 8.9

Dalmore cigar Malt Reserve is taken from a selection of aged stocks from 10-15years. Matured in American White oak ex bourbon barrels, 30 year old Matusalem Olorosso sherry casks, and then a final finesse in premier cru Cabernet Sauvignon wine barriques. A whisky to really savour, whether with a cigar or simply relaxing with a dram and watching the world go by.

THE DALMORE KING ALEXANDER III 40% 16.5

A sexy wood bottling from Dalmore. This auspiciously-named dram was matured in wine, Madeira, Sherry, Marsala, Kentucky bourbon and Port casks. King Alexander III is a rich, fruity Highland single malt.

DALWHINNIE 15 YEAR OLD 43% 4.1

Dalwhinnie 15 year old is a good introduction to the delights of single malt whisky. Elegant, smooth, and medium-bodied, with a light fruit palate and a slight whiff of heather on the finish.

DALWHINNIE WINTERS GOLD 43% 4.50

As the label remarks, it was "Crafted by the Cold". It's made only with spirit that has been distilled between October and March, and interestingly enough, they suggest that you try serving this expression frozen!

EDRADOUR SUPER TUSCAN 2006 46% 6.5

This Edradour is entirely matured in super Tuscan wine hogsheads. A very heavily bodied whisky, deep red fruit, dried oak and new leather. Aged for about 8 year, a fantastic rich whisky.

HIGHLANDS

GLENCADAM 14 YEAR OLOROSO FINISH 46% 5.7

The 14 year old Glencadam is finished in sweet Oloroso sherry casks for that little extra depth and complexity. A fantastic dram bottled at 46% ABV, with no caramel colour or chill filtration this is the natural way to make whisky. Lots of flavor

GLEN GARIOCH FOUNDERS RESERVE 48% 5.1

Founders's Reserve celebrates the brothers who first established the distillery and the 200 plus years of craftsmanship that goes into every bottle that bears the Manson name.

GLEN GARIOCH 12 YEAR OLD 48% 5.95

This 12 Year Old is a mix of ex-bourbon and sherry casks, and like the other distillery bottlings since the revamp, has been bottled at a feisty 48%.

GLENMORANGIE 10 YEAR OLD THE ORIGINAL 40% 3.9

The core of the Glenmorangie range, Glenmorangie Original is produced by marrying the delicate spirit that emerges from Scotland's tallest stills, with first and second fill American white oak casks. Very fruity & thick with rich vanilla & toffee. Nice and creamy, boiled fruit sweets and green apples.

GLENMORANGIE LASANTA 12 YEAR OLD 43% 5.6

The Lasanta is matured first in Bourbon casks before being finished in both Oloroso and Pedro Ximenez sherry casks and is said to mean 'warmth and passion' in Gaelic. Thick chocolate honeyed raisins, melted vanilla ice cream with a dusting of cocoa powder, a cracker of a dram

GLENMORANGIE 18 YEAR OLD 43% 9.5

A wonderfully creamy and thick 18 year old dram, matured for 15 years in ex bourbon casks before being finished in Oloroso sherry casks. An exquisite, tropical-fruit driven Glenmorangie.

HIGHLANDS

GLENMORANGIE QUINTA RUBAN PORT

FINISH 12 YEAR OLD 46% 5.6

To craft this single malt they specially selected Port pipes from the Douro valley in Portugal. A sweet and thick dram, chewy port, lots of juicy fruits and berries. A bold rich and sweet malt. Fantastic!

GLENMORANGIE SIGNET 46% 15

Distilled from malt using unique heavily roasted chocolate malt, this really beefs up the rich flavours. Some of this whisky is then matured in new charred oak barrels, added to a very complex recipe of whisky which also includes some of their oldest and rarest stock. This is a huge and intense whisky, lots of fresh espresso, cinnamon, sweet ginger, orange zest and sweet creamy vanilla. An absolute beauty.

GLENMORANGIE NECTAR D'OR SAUTERNES

FINISH 12 YEAR OLD 46% 5.3

The name Nectar D'Or is probably a reference to the golden nectar that was previously held in the casks used to finish the whisky. This sauternes finish from the range has notes of a dessert wine with notes of oak & spiced gingerbread, custard cream biscuits and white chocolate.

GLENMORANGIE 25 YEAR OLD 43% 24.8

Rounded and luxurious, Glenmorangie 25 has some lovely floral and citrus flavours alongside the spices and toasty sweetness one would expect from a quarter century in wood. A brilliantly made dram that lives up to the luxury image.

GLENGOYNE 12 YEAR OLD 40% 3.9

Nurtured then matured for 12 years. Natural colour from time spent oak and nothing more. Highland single malt scotch whisky with notes of Lemon Zest, toffee apples and a scent of coconut.

HIGHLANDS

GLENGOYNE CASK STRENGTH 58.9% 4.8

Digestive biscuits, ripe bananas and a hint of pepper. This is the taste of Scotland's slowest distillation, bottled as tradition insists: at cask strength, un-chill filtered. Like every Glengoyne, created simply by time and oak nothing more.

ISLE OF JURA 16 YEAR OLD, ISLANDS, JURA 43% 10

With the smoothness of the 10 year-old allied to extra complexity from more ageing, this is a winner. The 16 year-old, also subtitled 'Diurach's Own' after the name for the people of Jura, spends 14 years in ex-bourbon, and then is transferred for 2 years into Oloroso sherry casks to finish.

ISLE OF JURA TASTIVAL 2016, ISLANDS, JURA 51% 10.0

The 2016 special bottling for the Jura Tastival, which is held on the island each year. This year's release was finished in Palomino Fino, Amoroso Oloroso and Apostoles Oloroso Sherry casks.

ISLA OF JURA SUPERSTITION, ISLANDS, JURA 43% 4.2

Made up of whiskies aged for 13 & 21 years. A union of two Jura malt whisky styles: one bold, strong and peated, the other warm and delicate. Superstition is a unique whisky created from the marriage of traditional Islay style peated barley and a selection of aged malts. 13 percent heavily peated malt. Hints of white pepper, hot buttered toast & forest honey.

ANCNOC PETER ARKLE 2ND EDITION 46% 6.9

A limited edition bottling from AnCnoc, produced in collaboration with Scottish artist and designer Peter Arkle. This second edition has been matured in a combination of American and European oak casks. Full bodied whisky with sweet vanilla, a whiff of fresh citrus fruit with warm winter spices.

OBAN 14 YEAR OLD 43% 5.3

A bustling seaside resort has grown up around the distillery in the two centuries since it was first built in the fishing town of Oban. The West Highland malt is still produced in the same unhurried, traditional fashion and this 14 year old is a classic dram from the distillery.

HIGHLANDS

OBAN LITTLE BAY 43% 4.85

Oban Little Bay combines whisky matured in refill American oak hogsheads, European oak Sherry casks and refill casks with new ends for this expression before allowing the resultant single malt whisky to marry in small oak casks.

OLD PULTENEY 12 YEAR OLD 40% 3.9

A very popular highland dram, this whisky has a big sherry presence alongside sweet citrus fruit notes and a faintly detectable whiff of brine.

OLD PULTENEY 21 YEAR OLD 46% 12.9

Pulteney is the most northerly mainland distillery in Scotland and known for their love of the sea some of which rolls over into their whisky. The 21 year old is a mix of Oloroso sherry and refill bourbon cask matured whisky and sits at the top of their regular range.

RAASAY WHILE WE WAIT 46% 4.5

The Raasay distillery on the tiny Hebridean Island of Raasay is not quite in production yet. However R&B distillers, the people behind it are eager to show off their whisky making skills, and have released this beauty. Raasay While We Wait single malt. A blend of two single malts from the same undisclosed distillery, one peated, one unpeated then finished in Tuscan wine casks.

ROYAL LOCHNAGAR DISTILLERS EDITION 40% 7

A fine smooth dram finished in casks that previously contained well-aged Muscat wine, adding a floral richness to the spirit. Notes of walnut cake, fig and hints of strawberry jam. A fine whisky

SCAPA 25 YEAR OLD, ISLANDS ORKNEY 54% 17

Scapa 1980 is a belter of a malt from a distillery frequently overlooked in favour of its more famous Orcadian neighbour. There are notes of spicy barley and cinnamon, manuka honey and hints of chocolate orange and winter spice. Bottled at natural cask strength for added oomph.

HIGHLANDS

TOBERMORY LEDAIG 10 YEAR OLD, ISLANDS, ISLE OF MULL 46.3% 3.9

Peaty whisky from Tobermory on the Isle of Mull, named after a previous incarnation of the distillery. Maritime and smoky, this rivals some of the Islay drams for power, and the 10 year old balances the intensity of youth with rounded, well-aged spirit.

TALISKER 10 YEAR OLD, ISLANDS, ISLE OF SKYE 45.8% 3.8

A classic Island dram from the Isle of Skye. Always highly rated, a bartenders favorite. Lots of spice, pepper and fresh, tangy peat.

TALISKER DISTILLERS EDITION, 2000 ISLANDS, SKYE 45.8% 12

The 2003 vintage of Talisker's ever popular and quite excellent distillers edition. Double matured, with the finish in an Amoroso cask, adds a sweet and juicy fruit to Talisker's smoke and maritime edge

TALISKER PORT RUIGHE, ISLANDS, ISLE OF SKYE 45.8% 7.7

Port Ruighe the second non-aged statement from Talisker following Talisker Storm, is finished in Port casks after initial maturation in American & European Oak refill casks as well as casks that have been deeply charred. Milk chocolate, cocoa & mocha with the faintest orange pith and that famous Talisker smoke.

TALISKER STORM, ISLANDS, ISLE OF SKYE 45.8% 5.9

Talisker Storm has all the warm, smoky, peppery characteristics we all love in the Talisker 10. However they've been turned up a notch, with more smoke, more spices, and a bigger than ever flavour explosion. Wow

HIGHLANDS

TALISKER 25 YEAR OLD, ISLANDS, ISLE OF SKYE 45.8% 22

Talisker 25 a true smoky beast, amazing smoothness and warmth. It has a mature taste that only comes when drinking high quality whisky. Rich and spicy with a subtle warm fire, sweet caramel and seaweed. A beauty of a whisky, this single malt will blow you away

CAMPBELTOWN

A century ago Campbeltown was the heartland of the whisky industry. Back then, the city was famous as 'the capital of the whisky world'. But everything went pear-shaped at the start of the 20th century as a result of worldwide depression and prohibition in the USA, most distilleries closed and only 3 remain.

Campbeltown whiskies are medium to full-bodied, with some peat and saltiness.

GLEN SCOTIA, VICTORIANA 51.5% 8.9

Each whisky comes from Hand selected casks, chosen for their rare character and maturity. A malt that is bottled in the traditional way straight from the cask without filtration, it's subtle wood and vanilla flavour is enhanced by a full bodied spicy fruit aroma and mildly smokey aftertaste.

KILKERRAN 12 YEAR OLD 46% 6.25

After 12 years and lots of Work In Progress bottlings, the first core release of single malt Scotch whisky from the Glengyle Distillery. Kilkerran 12 Year Old is lightly peated and non-chill filtered.

LOWLANDS

The Lowlands region of malt whisky production takes in mainland Scotland below the theoretical “Highland Line” Very much like Campbeltown, The Lowlands never really recovered from prohibition and only 5 distilleries now produce lowland whisky. Stylistically, lowlands are traditionally the lightest and most delicate of all Scottish single malts.

AUCHENTOSHAN 12YEAR OLD 40% 4.1

Triple distilled then matured for over twelve years. This Lowland Single Malt Whisky has the tempting aroma of toasted almonds, caramelised toffee and the signature smooth, delicate, Auchentoshan taste.

AUCHENTOSHAN 3 WOOD 43% 4.4

The ever-popular Auchentoshan 3 Wood is matured initially in bourbon casks for at least ten years, before being finished for a good year in Oloroso then six months in a Pedro Ximénez cask for an extra layer of rich, sweet fruitiness.

GLENKINCHIE 12 YEAR OLD 43% 6.3

Fresh cereal, nutty & a slight taste of sweetness. Easy to understand why this is a great expression for a lowland.

AILSA BAY SINGLE MALT WHISKY 48.9% 6.25

The inaugural release from Ailsa Bay – peated Lowland whisky. The distillery can produce a variety of different styles of spirit and for this first release Grant’s have decided to go for smoke, creating a rare peated lowland. It’s got a rich and earthy backbone, with sweet liquorice and touches of tar.

SINGLE GRAIN

GIRVAN PATENT STILL NO 4 APPS 42% 5.35

A non-age-statement addition to William Grant & Sons growing collection of single grain Scotch whiskies comes in the shape of The Girvan Patent Still No. 4 App’s, which takes its name from the distillery term for ‘Apparatus’. No. 4 App’s has been in use at the Girvan distillery in Ayrshire since 1992. The single grain whisky itself spends its maturation in American oak barrels.

HAIG CLUB 40% 5.8

A very light & sweet grain whisky, aimed for drinkers that have not yet been won over by the charms of whisky. Named after John Haig, the founder of Cameron bridge distillery where the whisky is crafted. Seen by many as Scotland’s hidden gem.

BORDERS SINGLE GRAIN 51.7% 4.25

A light single grain whisky released by R&B distillers. Distilled in the Highlands and finished in Oloroso sherry casks. A very interesting whisky made up of 50% malted barley and 50% wheat, the only single grain Scottish whisky to do so.

A new super premium special edition release from Johnnie Walker whose launch was celebrated by an extraordinary around the world journey of 157 foot luxury yacht... Crafted from three carefully selected single malts, that are then married in European oak casks.

Johnnie Walker Green Label is a perfectly balanced blend of only single malt whiskies, crafted from a palette of Speyside, Highland, Lowland and Island malts matured for at least 15 years, delivering all the character of a single malt whisky, but with greater depth and a wider flavour experience.

Johnnie Walker's most prestigious whisky. Probably THE most famous super premium blend, crafted from the finest old-aged malt and grain whiskies. DOUGLAS LAING & CO, GLASGOW

EXTRA OLD PARTICULAR AUCHENTOSHAN, 1984, 30 YEAR OLD 53.9% 25

A ridiculously fine, rare and old dram bottled from a single cask. It was distilled in December 1984, aged in a refill Bourbon Barrel for 30 years. An amazing whisky, it really does get better with every sip.

SCALLYWAG, SPEYSIDE BLENDED MALT 46% 5

Scallywag is a Small Batch bottling created using only the finest Speyside Malts including – amongst others – Mortlach, The Macallan and Glenrothes.

INDEPENDENT

TIMOROUS BEASTIE,

HIGHLAND BLENDED MALT 46.8% 5.2

Timorous Beastie is a small batch bottling created using only the finest Highland Malts including - amongst others, those distilled at Glen Garioch, Dalmore and Glengoyne distilleries.

ROCK OYSTER, ISLAND BLENDED MALT 46.8% 5.2

Rock Oyster is a Small Batch bottling created using the finest maritime Malts including those distilled on the rightly esteemed Islands of Jura, Islay, Arran and Orkney.

ADELPHI, DUNFERMLINE

BRUICHLADDICH 2002, SINGLE CASK 63.9% 8.5

Drawn from a single ex-American oak cask, bottled by Adelphi. This whisky is surprisingly mild given its strength. Baked sponge and apricot jam, with a distinctive salty seaweed note in the background.

COMPASS BOX, EDINBURGH

HEDONISM, BLENDED GRAIN WHISKY 43% 8.5

A delightful blended grain whisky, Hedonism really is as enjoyable as the name suggests. Supple & silky. With elegant rich flavours of vanilla, toffee, coconut and cocoa.

SPICE TREE, BLENDED MALT 46% 5.7

Compass Box's delicious Spice is a blended malt made from Highland malt whiskies, aged in specially made casks with new French oak heads. Gingernut biscuits, vanilla and spices. A stunning whisky

OAK CROSS, BLENDED MALT 43% 5.2

Oak Cross gives the best characteristics of both American and French oak aging. A rich, medium-bodied blended malt Scotch whisky, Oak Cross combines vanilla characters from American oak and spicy, clove-like characters from French oak.

The Rare casks, from Abbey whisky comes this lovely smooth, peated Bunnahabhain, 23 years of age, from the mystical Isle, of Islay. Distilled in 1989, this special malt was aged in a refill bourbon barrel for 23 years before being bottled at natural cask strength

ANON DISTILLERY 13 YEAR OLD 51.5% 9

Here we have on our hands a beauty of whisky from Abbey Whisky, Distilled in 2001 at one of Scotland's finest distilleries, This whisky has been aged for 13 years in total, with the last 6 months of maturation spent in an Oloroso sherry cask., it's a beauty

WHISKEY OF IRELAND

The Irish may have been the first distillers in the British Isles and, for a brief period in the 19th century, Irish whiskey reigned supreme over its Scottish rival. Boom was followed by bust – and near extinction – but today the good times are back, with new distilleries popping up all over the Emerald Isle

IRISH SINGLE POT STILL WHISKEY

RED BREAST 15 46% 8.95

A beautiful Single Pot Still Whiskey. Redbreast 15 is a rich, thick, sweet, pungent whiskey with loads of flavour and complexity - really good stuff!

IRISH SINGLE MALT WHISKEY

TEELING 46% 4.9

Teeling's single malt contains whiskies aged for up to 23 years. These whiskies have been matured in a range of wine casks: sherry, port, Madeira, white Burgundy and Cabernet Sauvignon. A rich and spicy whiskey.

IRISH BLENDED WHISKEY

JAMESONS 40% 3.7

The Most popular Irish whiskey in the world. Produced from Middleton Distillery. Sweet and fruity, apple, mango, dried fruit and honey.

TULLAMORE DEW 40% 3.6

Big sherry notes on the nose with faint spice and toffee aromas. On the palate it's a very mellow whiskey with complexity and layers of flavour.

WHISKY OF JAPAN

The first Japanese whisky was distilled in 1923, when Masataka Taketsuru returned from an apprenticeship at Hazelburn distillery in Campbell town, Scotland to become Japan's first distiller at Suntory's Yamazaki distillery.

Japanese whisky is very similar to the Scottish template, Japan has always looked to Scotland for inspiration. Even today all barley is imported from Scotland & when it is required peat as well.

JAPANESE SINGLE MALT

HAKUSHU DISTILLERS RESERVE 43% 4.6

A green and crunchy entry in the Hakushu Range, combining whisky of a wide variety of ages, from across the range of casks used by the distillery to create a gently smoky dram, packed with fruity flavour.

YOICHI 10 YEAR OLD 45% 9.5

A ten year old, elegantly peaty single malt from Nikka's beautiful Yoichi distillery in Hokkaido, where whisky is made as it used to be in Scotland with small direct-fired stills and matured in the finest oak.

YAMAZAKI-18 YEAR OLD 43% 13.7

This has been Japans most successful single malt, launched in 1984. A wonderful example of what Japanese whisky is capable of. Beautiful stuff!! Extremely smooth, with great complexity and a lovely balance of fruit. Nice Silky malt with a touch of smoke.

JAPANESE BLENDED WHISKY

HIBIKI 17 YEAR OLD 43% 9.5

A fantastic Japanese blend, made with aged malt and grain whiskies from Suntory's three distilleries. Spicy and sophisticated, this is great for catching people out at blind tasting. Notes of cooked fruits, mixed peels with a nutty finish

NIKKA TAKETSURU 17 PURE MALT 43% 10.9

Fantastic 17 year old blended malt named after Nikka's founder, the whisky-pilgrim Masataka Taketsuru. It's a big, bold full-bodied vatted whisky of truly exceptional depth, grace and balance. Awesome whisky

NIKKA WHISKY FROM THE BARREL 51.4% 7.5

Nikka from the Barrel is a massive big bold whisky, it's bursting with character. Not averse to a drop of water, either. A real star, lots of caramel, toffee and winter spice. Another beauty from Nikka

JAPANESE GRAIN WHISKY

NIKKA COFFEY GRAIN 45% 5.5

The Nikka Coffey Grain is an original single grain whisky, distilled mainly from corn in a Coffey still. Exotic, fruity and unique, the unconventional whisky you're looking for.

WHISKEY OF THE WORLD

NORTH AMERICAN WHISKEY

North American whiskies are all-grain spirits that have been produced from a mash bill that usually mixes together corn, rye, wheat, barley and other grains in different proportions, and then generally aged for an extended period of time in wooden barrels. These barrels may be new or used, and charred or uncharred on the inside, depending on the type of whiskey being made. Each variation has its own unique flavours.

BUFFALO TRACE KENTUCKY

STRAIGHT BOURBON 40% 3.55

Really classy bourbon from the eponymous distillery that has been responsible for some truly outstanding products. Spicy and sweet with caramel, creamy toffee eclairs, hints of cinnamon.

BUFFALO TRACE EAGLE RARE

SINGLE BARREL 10 YEAR OLD 45% 6.2

This is top-drawer single barrel bourbon from Buffalo Trace; the Eagle Rare 10yo is deliciously fragrant and woody. A very bold whiskey, notes of toffee, caramel, orange pith and sweet honey. It's a belter.

BUFFALO TRACE EAGLE RARE

SINGLE BARREL 17 YEAR OLD 45% 14.6

Outrageously smooth and sophisticated. Only the very finest spirit can withstand ageing for seventeen sweltering Kentucky summers and still retain this level of quality.

WHISKEY OF THE WORLD

BUFFALO TRACE GEORGE T STAGG 45.9% 11.2

Created to represent whiskey before it was mass produced, Knob Creek embodies the look, feel and taste of pre-prohibition bourbon.

Bold was a 2015 addition to the core range. This is made entirely with Indian barley smoked using Islay peat to around 25ppm. A superb alternative to classic peated Scotch Whisky.

SULLIVANS COVE AMERICAN BOURBON FINISH, AUSTRALIA 47.5% 8.95

Sullivan's Cove is made in the Tasmanian Distillery and is producing a single malt whisky in a Scotch style. This bottling has been matured in ex-Bourbon barrels and uses water pulled from the surrounding rainforest.
