IRISH WHISKEY

First introduced and created by Catholic Monks on the Emerald Isle. Traditionally distilled three times, to be rightly named it must be produced in Ireland and have spent a minimum of 3 years in maturation.

Bushmills Original 3.3
Clean and crisp triple distilled

Bushmills Black Bush 3.5
Deep and complex blend, a spicy malt aged in Oloroso Sherry oak casks

Bushmills 10 Year 4.5
Award winning malt, smooth and peaty with hints of chocolate fudge and Sherry

Bushmills 21 Year 10.5
Served with rose lemonade and garnished with cucumber

Red Breast 12 Year 8.1
Sweet with spice and ripe fruit notes. Aged in Sherry and Bourbon casks – a wonderfully powerful taste

Greenore 3.8
Distilled from grain alone and matured in Bourbon casks. Smooth and sweet with a hint of caramel

Teeling Small Batch 4.1
Ripe fruity aromas, candyfloss, fresh apricot, pears and apples with some vanilla infused oak. Surprisingly soft at 46%

Paddy's 3.3
Triple distilled and produced in Cork. Oily with fresh notes, a dry, spicy finish with black pepper and oak

Teeling Single Grain 5.4
Partly matured in Californian red wine barrels. Smooth, soft and very easy going

Teeling Single Malt 5.3
Winner of the "best Irish Single Malt 2015" at the world Whiskey awards. A rich and spicy finish

Connemara 4.2
Rich, sweet and smoky malt, with fruity flavours and full bodied peaty undertones

Pogues 4.7
Blended Whiskey aged in Sherry and Bourbon casks. Smoky with a hint of honey

Jameson 3.3
A classic blend, full and floral sweet nose, a medium length finish with spice and honey

Kilbeggan 3.3
Light and smooth with notes of honey

SCOTTISH WHISKY

Native to a Scottish distillery, made from malted barley or a mash of grain mixed with water, distilled twice and matured in wood casks with a minimum of 40% ABV at time of bottling.

ISLAY

Bunnahabhain 12 Year 4.5
Lightly peated for an Islay single malt so consequently it is a light and fresh dram

Caol Ila 4.5
Lightly medicinal, smoky, salty and sweet with a dry peppery finish

Lagavulin 16 Year 5.6
One of the smokiest notes from Islay. Spicy finish with figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla and salt.

Laphroaig 10 Year 4.5
Smoky and iodine rich – one of Scotland's most character full drams, add a drop of water to bring out the flavours.

SPEYSIDE

Glenfiddich 12 Year 4.1

Delicate, floral, slightly fruity nose with a smooth oak finish

Glenfiddich 15 Year 4.7

Matured in Bourbon, Sherry and virgin oak, married in a Solera vat. Sherry and candied fruits on the nose with a hint of smoke

The Glenlivet 12 Year 4.1

The nose is full and rich, with notes of creamy vanilla, toffee and aniseed. Finish is long and warming

Balvenie Doublewood 12 Year 4.9

Single malt which gains its distinctive character from being matured in two woods. Nutty sweetness with cinnamon notes

Aberlour 10 Year 4.1

A pure single Highland malt from which draws its water from the slopes of Ben Rinnes, adding to its unique characteristics

ISLAND

Talisker 4.3

A classic Island dram from the Isle of Skye. Lots of spice and fresh tangy peat with a long finish

Jura 10 Year 4.3

A light, sweet whisky, with gentle toffee, caramel and easy going malty notes

Highland Park 12 Year 4.3

A great all-rounder. Smoke and sherry wood create a heather honey sweetness

LOWLAND

Auchentoshan 4.5

Triple distilled, aromas of toasted almonds, caramelised toffee and a smooth delicate taste

HIGHLAND

Oban 14 Year 5.0

Medium bodied, initially sweet but develops greater complexity with spice, orange, smoke and dries as it envelops

Old Pulteney 12 Year 4.1

Matured in Bourbon casks. Crisp and clean with notes of herbs, parsley and almond with a finish of oak and spice

Old Pulteney 21 Year 9.5

Rated the best Whisky in Jim Murray's 2012 Whisky Bible. Light and subtle with delicate fruit and floral notes. A kick of spice on the palate with a dry finish of honey

Glenmorangie 4.7

Rich notes of lemon, nectarine, apple and spices. The finish is long, gentle, malty and fruity with a hint of ginger

Dalwhinnie 15 Year 4.1

A gentle, delicate malt from the wild and windswept Highlands, a subtle, smooth and delicately smoky malt with a honey finish



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
