Maison Saturnin Blanc, Grenache Noir - 12.5% - £4.90 / £6.90 / £17.50

Languedoc, France Dominated by aromatic red fruit on the nose and concentrated red fruit flavours.

Château Laulerie Merlot, Bergerac - 13.5% - £5.65 / £7.65 / £19.50

Vignoble Dubard SW France This unoaked red wine is medium weight with ripe fruit flavours and soft tannins.

Monte Llano - 13.5% - £5.55 / £7.05 / £20

Rioja, Spain, bright violet red with purple hues. Ripen red grapes, redcurrants and blackberries.

Skaapveld Shiraz, MAN Family Wines - 14% - £5.90 / £8.05 / £22.50

Western Cape, South Africa Distinctive aromas of ripe plum and pepper spices.

Podere Montepulciano d'Abruzzo - 13% - £6.10 / £8.25 / £23.50

Abruzzo, Italy This medium bodied, dry wine has a finely textured structure and ripe, plummy fruit.

Reserve Malbec, Bodegas Santa Ana - 14% - £6.45 / £8.75 / £24.50

Mendoza, Argentina Powerful with stone fruit aromas of plums and prunes and a hint of spicy oak.

Chateau Bonnet Red, Les Vignobles Andre Lurton - 13% - £26.50 bottle

Bordeaux, France This appetising wine has black fruit flavours and a touch of strawberry.

Unravelled Pinot Noir, Carrick Winery - 14% - £31.50 bottle

Central Otago, New Zealand Ripe berries and black cherries on the nose which transfer onto the palate with a hint of oak. Finely balanced, fruit forward styled wine.

Phantom, Bogle Vineyards - 14.5% - £35.50 bottle

California, United States of America Deeply luscious and succulent blackberries, aromas of anise and sweet fig are embraced by touches of black pepper.

Keyneton Estate Euphonium, Henschke - 14% - £40.50 bottle

South Australia The palate is ripe with a fleshy texture, excellent depth and powdery tannins.

Conti D'Arco Prosecco, Brut - 11% - £5.70 / £25.50

Italy Produced from grapes grown in the north-east of Italy; this wine is classic Prosecco with an abundance of fizz and a wonderful palate of fresh apple, pear and a just a hint of white peach.

Champagne Louis Dornier et Fils Brut - 12% - £7.60 / £39.50

France A light, fresh, vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate. Outstanding value and consistently good. There is a high percentage of Pinot grapes (both Noir and Meunier) in the blend.

Cordon Rouge Brut, Mumm - 12% - £48.00 bottle

France Rich and yellow in colour, peach and apricot flavours with subtle hints of toasted nuts and hints of vanilla.

Special Cuvée, Bollinger - 11.5% - £68.00 bottle

France The nose is lemon, apple pie and brioche; the palate is fine with lots of toasty and baked apple flavours.
