With white glove service, this delicate tea is weighed with precision using golden scales; each tip is placed into a silver teapot individually with golden tweezers.

Infused with still mineral water it produces an extraordinary liquor and a smooth, light and mellow texture, with hints of fruity notes.

RUBENS GOLDEN TIPS TEA

CEYLON, SRI LANKA

The special hand-picked blend is plucked by expert tea pluckers who skilfully hand pick the tips of the small, succulent shoots of a special tea plant at sunrise. The buds are then sundried on a velvet cloth with the upmost care, turning the buds from silver to gold.

BLACK TEA

THE RUBENS ROYAL TEA BY GOLDEN GARDEN ESTATE

Hand-picked and handmade by the expert tea maker on Golden Garden. The leaf is personally tended to by the Tea Maker who hand sifts the tea to extract the "tip". Golden Garden has a balance of strength and flavour, as the extra "tip" found in this tea gives a mild sweetness to the cup. Thick, malty with a bittersweet finish.

THE ROYAL JUBILEE TEA BY LOVERS LEAP TEA ESTATE, NUWARAELIYA, CEYLON

The estate takes its name from two lovers who leapt to their fate. HRH The Duke of Edinburgh visited this estate on a Royal tour of the island in 1954. The Duke took to the fields by planting a selection of tea bushes during his visit. Lovers Leap tea was the only tea served and drunk by those in attendance of the state banquet dinners during the Diamond Jubilee celebrations for 2012. The flavours are bright, crisp and clean – a lighter cup without milk.

INVERNESS TEA EST ATE - CEYLON HALMARI TEA EST ATE - ASSAM

The dry leaf contains selectively plucked and delicately rolled leaves with a generous sprinkling of chunky golden buds. The cup is a deep ruby coloured liquor with strength and flavour, with a signature creamy chocolate note that its seasonal tea is known for. Can be enjoyed plain or with milk.

OKAYTI TEA EST ATE – 1ST FLUSH DARJEELING

One of Darjeeling's most picturesque plantations. This 150-year-old grand plantation started life named Rangdoo. However, its teas were so highly acclaimed at the London auctions that they became known as 'the only okay tea' and subsequently the estate was named Okayti, or Okay Tea. The soil and unique climatic conditions of this plantation produces teas of subtle delicacy.

INVERNESS PEKOE DIMBULA

Dimbula seasonal Pekoe grade produces a cup that is amber in colour, with a golden rim to the cup. The tea boasts a wonderful aroma, with a distinctive oaky note that is only found in its seasonally made tea. Dimbula tea is used in blends the world over. Enjoy it pure and fresh, straight from the garden. Can be enjoyed with a splash of milk.

PLANTERS' GREEN

ROOIBOS
