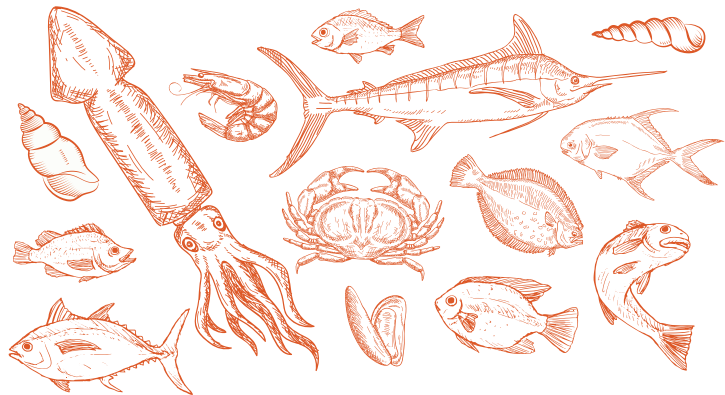

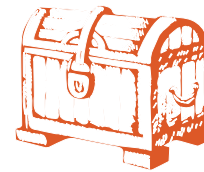
P.s. Remember a squid is not a fish!
