RED Ai Galera 'Poetico' Castelão - Trincadeira - Tinta Miúda, Tejo, Portugal **5.50/14* /20**

Portuguese wines are unusual to find on any UK wine list. Give this a try and let us know what you think.

Los Espinos Merlot, Chile **7/17*/25**

A typical delicate Merlot and another good value wine.

Bella Modella Primitivo, Italy **7/17*/25**

Ruby red with hints of blackcurrants and plum. From Puglia comes this wonderful little Primitivo.

Felicette 'Cats In Space Suits' Grenache Noir, France **25**

Felicette was the first French being in space, just happens to have been a cat! A nice blend of plums, raspberries and a hint of violet.

Belhara Estate 'Amayan' Malbec, Argentina **8/21*/30**

From Mount Tupungato, which is huge. Properly massive and some mad fool decided to plant Malbec up there.

Scotto Family Vineyards Old Vine Zinfandel, USA **30**

Zinfandel is such a confusing grape can make anything from a light rose to a full bodied red. This is something nearer the latter.

Finca Manzanos Rioja Crianza, Spain **30**

Minimum 18 months in oak. This Rioja Crianza is typically fruity and fresh and will go very very well with any of our grilled meats.

Château Grand Gamelle, Entre-Deux-Mers, France **35**

Bordeaux is often just so boring. But we found this beauty just to prove the exception to that rule. Heavier in tannins so works better with food.

Domaine Fichet Organically Farmed Bourgogne Pinot Noir, France **40**

The Fichet brothers are cool dudes. They make cool, elegant wines too. Outrageously drinkable.

Cartlidge & Browne North Coast Cabernet Sauvignon, USA **45**

Tony Cartlidge used to operate a cement mixer. Honest. Now he makes the best wine on our list.
