Sparkling

Prosecco, Gocce di Favola, Veneto, Italy, NV

A fresh, fragrant and fruit Prosecco with aromas of pear and apple. On the palate it is off-dry and lively with an attractively crisp finish.

Taittinger Brut Reserve, Champagne, France, NV

Taittinger Brut Réserve, is assembled from more than 35 crus and incorporates 40% Chardonnay-this high proportion is seldom offered in a non-vintage Champagne. Distinguished by a delicate nose marked by subtle brioche notes, it has a palate of considerable depth and balance with hints of honey and fresh fruit.

Simpsons Chalklands Classic Cuvee, Kent, England, 2016

Beautifully delicate, floral aromas of millefeuille and citrus. Fine and precise on the palate, with delicious hints of caramelised pear.

Taittinger Brut Prestige Rose, Champagne, France, NV

A shimmering pink Champagne. Its subtle balance of soft red fruits and crisp acidity, this wine is velvety, full-bodied and refined.

Vermentino, Les Boules Blanc, Southern, France

Les Boules Blanc Vin de France is a fresh, yet subtly exotic southern French blend of Vermentino (Rolle) grapes with Sauvignon Blanc. It shows ripe citrus character with mouth-watering floral overtones. On the palate, there is enough body to pair well with grilled fish.

Picpoul de Pinet, Grange des Rocs, Languedoc, France

Thirst-quenching wine designed for shellfish. Crisp, herbal and slightly buttery, very easy to drink indeed. Lovely wine that works perfectly for who's after a more traditional white.

Pinot Grigio, Novita, Umbria, Italy

Novita Pinot Grigio is a fresh, vibrant, dry Pinot Grigio from the vineyards of Umbria in central Italy. It shows citrus flavours with a hint of tropicality, underpinned by a decent body and fine acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc, Naciente Morande, Chile

This fresh flavoured Sauvignon Blanc combines grassy aromas of zesty passion fruit with refreshing flavours of lemon sherbert.

Chablis, Domaine Grand Roche, France

Fresh, bright aromas of citrus fruit and floral notes are elegantly enveloped in subtle, smoky mineral notes. Crisp on the palate, with refreshing, vibrant white fruits complemented by a hint of butter, good structure through to a dry, mouthwatering finish.

Sancerre, Domaine Des Brosses, Loire, France

A classic Sancerre from an historic Domaine owned and run by the Girard family since 1973. Nicolas and brother Anthony are making fresh, modern and aromatic wines, and this is a super example of quality Loire Sauvignon Blanc.

Red

Heraldique "Cuvee Prestige Rouge", Languedoc, France, 2018

A selection of typical southern French grapes combine in a rich, full-bodied and characterful blend full of ripe berried fruit and heady with the scent of garrigue.

Nero d'Avola, Cielo Rosso, Sicily

Fresh, fruity, organic, naturally made red wine from Sicily. Cielo make excellent value organic wines and this entry level Nero d'Avola has bags of crunchy, fresh dark fruits and spice to keep you happy with some simple Italian pasta dishes.

Pinot Noir, Naciente, Casablanca, Chile

Light, delicate and great value Pinot Noir from one of Chile's more premium sub-region, Casablanca Valley. Plenty of notes of strawberry and raspberry with a touch of cherry. A great mid-week wine, perfect with foods such as chicken, duck and pork.

Tempranillo/Granacha,

La Montesa Rioja Crianza, Rioja, Spain

Ripe, polished Garnacha, with notes of herbs and spice, and a slight seasoning of Tempranillo. Long, confident, finely integrated oak, full-flavoured finish.

Pomerol, Chateau De Valois, Bordeaux, France

The nose is bursting with black berries, exotic spice and hints of smoky oak and cedar. On the palate, the texture is rich and generous, with soft tannins. The finish has a good freshness and is full of lingering ripe fruit.

Rose

Grenache/Syrah, Le Campuget, Languedoc, France

A delicate pale pink, with a fresh wild strawberries and hints of grapefruit on the nose. Refreshing with a persistent finish, completed by subtle hints of nectarine.

Cotes de Provence, Chateau

De L'Aumerade Cuvée Henri Fabré Rosé, France

Pale salmon in colour, this is the quintessential Provence rosé. A refreshingly fruity bouquet leads to delicate white spice and mineral flavours on the palate and an elegant finish.

Merlot, San Abello, Central Valley, Chile

Deep pink in colour with fresh, fruity aromas and luscious, juicy flavours of redcurrant, cherry and strawberry. Easy drinking and refreshing.

Sancerre Rose, Les Baronnes Henri Bourgeois, Loire, France

Refreshing, fruity, dry rosé. This delicious rosé from renowned Sancerre producer Henri Bourgeois is produced from 100% Pinot Noir grown on Sancerre's chalky soils.
