ÒRAN MÓR

MORE THAN JUST A GREAT BAR

the ÒRAN MÓR story



Òran Mór was founded as the Kelvinside Free Church, with the foundation stone laid on 4th September 1862. Throughout the 1900's, the church served as a Parish church of the Church of Scotland for the people of Kelvinbridge and Hillhead. By the late 1970's the congregation had dwindled, and in 1978 it was decided to merge Kelvinside Parish Church with Hillhead Parish Church, with the latter building retained for worship. Consequently, the former Kelvinside Parish Church became redundant and derelict on its prominent site on the corner of Byres Road and Great Western Road.

In 2002, the inimitable **Colin Beattie** began what would become an enduring labour of love to transform the building into a multi-purpose venue, with a focus on the arts and events. The refurbishment of Òran Mór was painstaking and ambitious, bringing together some of the greatest minds in Scotland to bring Colin's vision to life. **Peter McGurn**, the Project Architect, lived a stone's throw from the project himself and **Alasdair Gray**, a globally renowned artist and writer, was brought on board to paint a mural on the ceiling of the Auditorium which would go on to become Scotland's largest piece of public art.

Public support for the project was tremendous, and was aided by the wonderfully eclectic programme of events and shows the venue brought to the area, most notably **A Play, A Pie & A Pint**, which to this day endures as Scotland's longest running daytime theatre initiative and regularly plays to sold-out crowds. The building was opened in June 2004, and consisted of a labyrinth of gig, event & dining spaces, all wrapped lovingly around what was, in essence, a very good pub.

In the two decades since, Òran Mór (*Scots Gaelic for "Big Song"*) has continued to live up to its name, with an illustrious list of musicians having taken to the stage here, including **Amy Winehouse, Lana del Ray, Lewis Capaldi, Simply Red** and **The Proclaimers**, cementing the legacy of Òran Mór as "the best pub ever imagined."
